

T E R M S O F U S E

Please read the following Terms and Conditions carefully before using this site. If you do not agree to these Terms, please do not use the Site.

Schoolyard Films, Inc. is an online educational service offering media resources appropriate for K-12 curriculum, for use in lessons or independent study (the "Service"). This Schoolyard Films, Inc. owns this site (including all services, functionality, and content available through the schoolyardfilms.org domain name, collectively, the "Site"). The terms and conditions (the "Terms") set forth herein apply to all information, online communications, services, text, video, audio files, graphics, still images, links, or other material and content that is or becomes available on the Site or is otherwise offered for the Service (collectively, "Content"). By accessing or using the Site, you specifically agree to abide by these terms and conditions and any modifications thereto. If you do not agree to these Terms, please do not use the Site.

A. Restrictions on Use of Site and Content
